

## ANTICHLOR

Chlorine neutraliser for laundry liquid feed systems.

### Introduction

In laundering chlorine bleach is used extensively to remove stains, sanitise linen and maintain whiteness. If any chlorine is retained by the fabric the heat of drying or ironing converts the chlorine into a form that is very damaging to textiles – especially cotton. Antichlor is applied during one of the rinse operations following chlorine bleaching to “strip” the last traces of chlorine from the fabric.

### Features and Benefits

- Antichlor is totally soluble in water will not form gels.
- Antichlor is easily and accurately dispensed through liquid feed systems.

### Use Directions

Use 1.5 millilitre of Antichlor for each 1 ppm of chlorine for every 100 litres of rinse water.
