### Use Directions

For cleaning demountable equipment such as taps or extractors, rinse components with water then immerse in a solution of 15mL BEER LINE CLEANER per litre of water. Brush if required and rinse thoroughly with clean water.

For cleaning beer lines, use in accordance with brewery recommendations. Flush beer lines with water then fill with a solution containing 150 mL of BEER LINE CLEANER for each 10 litres of beer line capacity. Allow solution to remain in lines as long as possible, then flush lines with fresh water.
