Mixing Instructions

Always dispense, measure, mix and use this product in clean plasticware or stainless steel. Never use mild steel, brass, aluminium or any other metal for this purpose.

Never mix Bleach with any other chemical product as they may neutralize the bleach or may cause dangerous reactions.

5 mls of Bleach in one litre of water produces a concentration of 200 parts per million available chlorine which is sufficient for most applications.

Use Directions:

- 1) Bathrooms
To remove stubborn stains, disinfect and deodorize the bath, basin, floor, shower recess, tiles, grouting and all other hard surfaces. Wash the area, then wipe with a cloth dipped in a solution containing 5 mls of bleach per litre of water.
- 2) Kitchens
Great for disinfecting food preparation areas and floors. It should be used with care on aluminium and silver as they may discolour. Use at strength of 5 mls per litre of water.
- 3) Laundry
Excellent for whitening whites and disinfecting the wash. Just add 50 mls to the wash prior to adding the clothes. If this is difficult, pre-mix 50 mls of Bleach into a litre of water and add to the machine.

Never use Bleach on coloured fabrics or drip-dry materials, silk, woolens, rayon or acetate.
- 4) Mould and Moss
Bleach will instantly kill black and green mould found in bathrooms and showers. It will also kill green moss found growing in damp areas. Mix Bleach with an equal amount of water and spray onto mould or moss.
